



Conduct

The following rules of conduct apply to all classes.

We at SKRA expect our players, coaches and parents behavior to be above reproach. The umpires will be in control of the games and must be respected. No player or parent will challenge an umpire's decision. Only the coaches may protest or talk to the umpire about the game. Name calling, excessive celebration or taunting will not be allowed from anyone. This is a game for the kids and sportsmanship is the key at all times. The following will be the discipline code:

- 1.) Warning
- 2.) Ejection
- 3.) Suspension

If the umpire feels too much trash talk or complaining is taking place; he or she will warn the player, parent or coach. A second warning will result in an ejection. If a player, parent or coach is ejected from a game they will be SUSPENDED for one game!!! Two ejections in one year and the player, parent or coach will be kicked out of the league. Swearing at anyone is an automatic ejection. This applies to everyone. Anyone ejected from a game is required to leave the complex.

Coaches please remember and remind our players and parents why we are here, for the kids, and for fun. Team play and sportsmanship are the only reasons we are here. Let's teach our athletes what sports are all about.

Field Decorum

- 1.) The actions of Players, Managers, Coaches and Umpires must be above reproach. Managers are responsible for the actions of their team, their parents, and their fans.
- 2.) Uniformed players, Managers, Coaches, scorekeeper and the umpire only shall be permitted within the confines of the playing field just prior to and during the games. Except for the batter, base runners, player on deck and coaches for the field and bases, all other personnel shall remain in the bench area when the team is at bat. When the team is on defense the reserve players shall remain in the bench area or in the bullpen.
- 3.) Managers shall not leave their dugout except to confer with players, umpires or when as a base coach.

Cancelled Games

- 1.) Games are cancelled prior to game time due to: Tornado Watch or Warning, Severe Storm Warnings and School Activities (as determined by the board).
- 2.) If games are not cancelled in advance, the decision to begin playing, or continue playing in the case of suspended games, will be made by SKRA board members that are present.
- 3.) Most cancelled games will be rescheduled for the following Saturday. Some, by necessity, may be scheduled at another time or not played at all, at the discretion of the board
- 4.) If none of the above are in effect all teams and umpires must report to their respective fields for the game.
- 5.) If a game is called by the umpire for any reason, which in the umpire's judgment interferes with further play and the minimum innings have not been played, the game will be continued from the point the umpire called the game. Both coaches must contact the board member present to inform him of the game situation at the point the umpire called the game.
